



## 2 DAY SAI KUNG GEOPARK TOUR

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Hong Kong is blessed with some magnificent coastal scenery - in fact the United Nations has recognised that a large part of our NE coastline is globally unique and have declared it a UNESCO Global Geopark due to its very specific volcanic features.

These features include vertical cliffs, deep inlets and bays, columns of volcanic rocks, sea caves and sea arches. There are even natural tunnels through islands, that if the conditions are perfect, can be kayaked through.

Our 2 day sea kayak tour takes us in and around the Shelter Bay section of the Geopark with it's many

volcanic islands, clean blue ocean, white sandy beaches and coral reefs.

### BASIC ITINERARY

All kayaking times are approximate and can be subject to change due to weather and sea conditions.

#### Day 1:

- 10:00 am - meeting in Sai Kung.
- 10:30 am - pack sea kayaks ready for departure
- 11:00 am - commence kayaking, Shelter Bay
- 13:00 pm - lunch and swim
- 16:00 pm - arrive Pak Lap camping place
- 17:00 pm - Establish camp / change into dry clothes
- 17:00 - 19:00 - cook dinner / cleanup

### TOUR FEATURES

- Remote, uninhabited islands
- Snorkelling on coral reef
- Beach camping
- Mostly sheltered waters



ITINERARY (cont).

**Day 2:**

- 08:00 am - breakfast
- 09:00 am - decamp & prepare for departure
- 10:15 am - depart Pak Lap beach
- 12:00 noon - lunch / swim
- 13:00 pm - sea kayak Shelter Bay
- 16:00 pm - arrive Sai Kung, unpack kayaks.
- 16:30 pm - trip ends!

Sea kayak routes:

There are many choices of routes to explore Shelter Bay in the UNESCO Global Geopark. The routes followed on the day will be determined by many factors, but mainly the wind direction and speed, the state of the seas and the capabilities of the paddlers.

Your sea kayak guide will make the decision on the day of travel.



## HOW TO GET TO SAI KUNG

### Public Transport:

#### Red Mini-Bus

Take the Sai Kung Red mini-bus from Mong Kok which departs every 5 to 10 minutes from Dundas Street, Mong Kok. This is an express bus and usually takes around 45 minutes to arrive in Sai Kung. It terminates at the main bus stop, a 5 minute walk to the Macdonald's meeting place.

Cost Approx HK\$24

#### Taxi

A taxi from Central to Sai Kung bus terminal will take approximately 35 to 45 minutes.

Cost HK\$150. + \$5 for every bag in the trunk.

Capacity: A taxi can carry 4 or 5 passengers.

#### Private Car

It will take approximately the same time to drive as a taxi, depending on which location to commence. A car park is available opposite Macdonald's in Sai Kung.

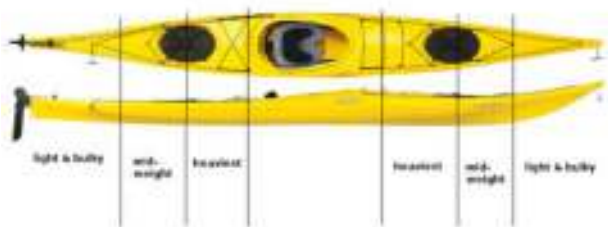


**Trip & Packing List - Sea Kayak Expeditions 2 day**

There are baggage limits, just like the airlines

The hatch openings you'll be packing into are 25 cm and 20 cm across so don't bring excess gear.

Remember that all the food, personal and clothing need to fit in these hatches and the kayaks.



**Paddling Stuff**

- 1.5 litre water bottle
- Sunscreen and lip protection
- Sunglasses with strap
- Strap for regular glasses
- Hat for sun

- Long-sleeve shirt for paddling (preferably cotton)
- Quick-dry shorts/pants
- Water shoes or sandals with heel strap
- Bathing suit

**Personal Stuff**

- Toothpaste & tooth brush
- Shampoo, soap
- Camera (in waterproof case or bag)
- Spare batteries for everything
- Medications (if required)
- Sense of adventure!

**Camping Stuff**

- Towel
- Camp T-shirt (s)
- Windbreaker jacket
- Long pants (light)
- Socks & shoes or sandals
- Underwear
- Head lamp
- Sleeping bag (in compression sack)
- Plastic bag for wet stuff
